HENLEY THEATRE SERVICES have announced their latest anti-viral fogging service to combat Covid-19 with the hope that their nano-technology disinfectant can help theatres reopen safely at a time where many within the arts industry are facing closure and many theatres are on the brink of ruin.

Their latest anti-viral fogging service allows theatres to completely decontaminate their premises with surfaces protected for up to 10 days following application, giving a realistic option to businesses who require large audiences to survive. The non-toxic, eco-friendly, medical grade product can safely be used on all surfaces including upholstery and food preparation areas, leaving a clear invisible film that releases disinfectant slowly, to kill many viruses that comes into contact with it, including Covid-19.
